Stamford is an outstanding stone town built on the Jurassic rock outcrop which stretches from Dorset to Yorkshire. It has fine examples of period architecture, ranging from remnants of medieval monasteries to 19th century stone houses.

Stamford Civic Society was formed by a small group of dedicated enthusiasts in the early 1960s who set about defending the town's heritage and actively fighting for its preservation. In 1967 Stamford became the first Urban Conservation Area. A major book by the Royal Commission followed, detailing the long architectural history of the town and confirming the vitality of its unique built environment.

Today the Society works to conserve and enhance the built and social fabric of the town, and to inform people about Stamford's fascinating history. It is also keen to foster good design for the future and supports innovative and environmentally-friendly developments. Its Committee keeps closely in touch with local issues and actively influences the planning process.
